The Chattanooga Lookouts have noticed their share of good news recently, With center fielder Byron Buxton joining the Minnesota Twins last Sunday and the category AA franchise on Thursday night capturing its first Southern League first half division title since 2006.

If only the timing may have been a little better.

Buxton were built with a .283 batting average and was leading the minor leagues with 12 triples whilst his promotion.
